

# Proposed changes to Plantation Road Mine Grouting Area

Since submitting our planning application in April 2021 we have made changes to our proposals for this area following further consultation with statutory consultees and taking into consideration local resident comments received by Hyndburn Borough Council in response to our planning application. We will soon be submitting an update to our planning application to reflect these changes and our updated proposals.

## What are the changes?

We have revised the red line boundary along the access routes to our proposed mine grouting working areas to incorporate further mitigation proposals to improve safety of vehicle movements in this area and minimise disruption to others. The changes are illustrated in the map and are summarised in the following bullets;

- Widening of Sandy Lane to allow 2-way traffic to a new temporary access point from Sandy Lane
- Temporary relocation of cattle grid away from the A56 and new temporary access into the field off Sandy Lane
- Additional work at the road junctions from the A56
- Widening of our planning red line boundary areas along sections of Plantation Road and Brox Heights Lane to facilitate vehicle movements
- Additional working area to avoid reported historic tip

The above will be detailed in Supplementary Environmental Information that we will submit to Hyndburn Borough Council as part of the planning application process. As the planning authority, Hyndburn Borough Council, will make this information available online, seek input from consultees, and be open to receive comment on the changes.
