

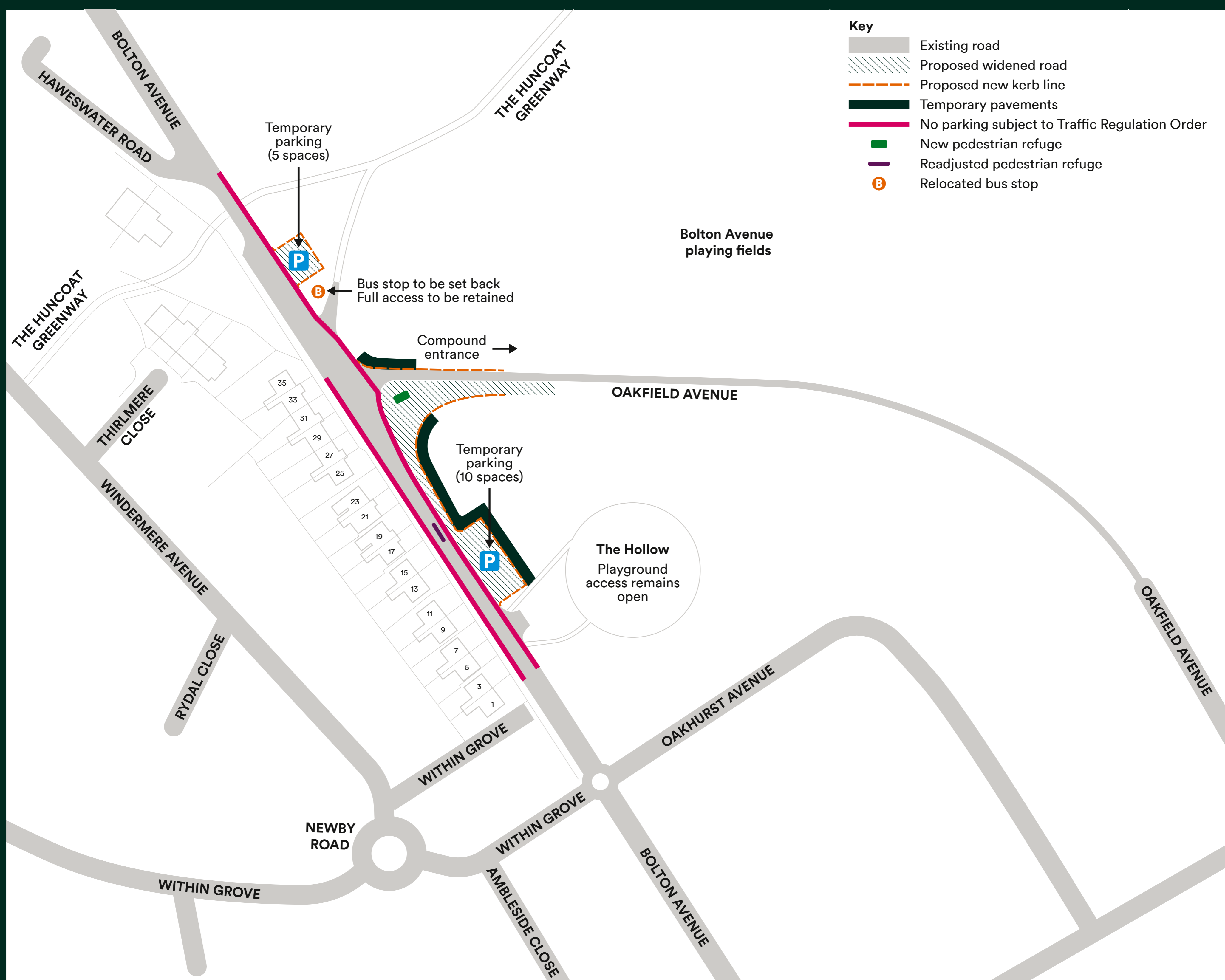
Update to Bolton Avenue Compound access proposals

In April 2021, we submitted our planning application to Hyndburn Borough Council for the Haslingden and Walmersley section. We have been reviewing the feedback from the public through the planning process and working closely with your Local Planning Authority and Lancashire County Council Highways Authority and as a result our plans have been updated.

What are the changes?

Our changes include enhanced proposals within the Huncoat area along the roads our construction vehicles will use to access the Bolton Avenue Compound. For the safety of road users and to help provide safe access to our plans for the Bolton Avenue compound we're proposing:

- A temporary parking restriction along a section of Bolton Avenue between Within Grove and Haweswater Road as shown on the enclosed map. This will allow safe entry and exit of vehicles to/from the Bolton Avenue compound. Restrictions would generally apply Monday to Saturday lunchtime.
- To mitigate the parking restriction and compound access, we're proposing 15 parking spaces to provide additional temporary off road parking which have been illustrated on the map below.
- An extension of the 30mph speed limit on Burnley Road from Accrington Cemetery to the junction of the A56 with speed reducing measures.



Next steps

The above is detailed in Supplementary Environmental Information that we have submitted to Hyndburn Borough Council as part of the planning application process. As the planning authority, Hyndburn Borough Council will make this information available online, seek input from consultees and be open to receive comment on the changes.
